Attendance Policy: Attendance at summer school is mandatory for both teacher led and APEX classes. Any student absent for more than one day will be dropped and receive a failing grade. Arriving more than 15 minutes into the start of class both at the beginning of the day or coming back from lunch will be considered as absent.

- 1st absence - Is allowed
- 2nd absence - Dropped from summer school and will receive a failing grade.

Tardy Policy: Arriving late to the start of the day or coming back from lunch (less than 15 minutes) will be considered tardy.

- 1-3 Tardies - Is allowed
- 4th Tardy - Dropped from summer school and will receive a failing grade.

Behavior Policy: Students will conduct themselves appropriately both in class and in the building. Class disruptions, cell phone referrals, removal from class, wandering the halls, or any other inappropriate behavior may result in being dropped from summer school and receiving a failing grade.

Restrooms: The ONLY restrooms that we will utilize are outside Student Services 10-12. All other restrooms and areas of the building are OFF LIMITS. Students found in these areas will receive a referral and may result in being dropped from summer school and receiving a failing grade.

Lunch: Will be open campus. The South Cafeteria will be available for students who bring lunch. There will also be a very limited number of menu items available for purchase (Including, but not limited to Uncrustables, chips, granola

bars, and water) in the south cafeteria. Deliveries or DoorDash to the school is not permitted. Please remember that students will not be allowed to roam the building during their lunch times.
