Commencement Plans

Commencement is Thursday, May 30th, at 7:30pm. In the event of inclement weather and the timing of the weather, commencement may be moved earlier in the day or later in the evening in order to allow for an enjoyable celebration for graduates and their families. This may include using Friday, May 31st, if the original day is not suitable for commencement. More details will be shared as we get closer to the big day.

Outdoor Commencement (BBCHS Stadium)

- ★ Each graduate will receive eight tickets for admission to Commencement. Ticket information will be coming in late May.
- ★ Gates to the Stadium will open 90 minutes prior to the ceremony.
- ★ Seating will only be available in the bleachers on either side of the field. A special location for wheelchair seating will be available. Wheelchair seating will be for a wheelchair plus one additional person. Other attendees will be seated in the bleachers.
- ★ Chairs for graduates will be set up in rows across the turf. The stage will be located at the north end of the field facing south.
- ★ Graduates will cross the stage utilizing both sides. and they will exit from the middle of the stage to return to their seats.
- ★ Graduates will recess to the baseball field and reunite with family in the parking lot or another predetermined location.

These final months are very special days that will be remembered for a long time. It is my hope that BBCHS has been a great experience for you and has prepared you for whatever lies ahead. I am proud of you and for your perseverance throughout high school. Enjoy the final semester; finish strong!
