BBCHS and KCC Partnership

EARN COLLEGE CREDIT FROM KCC WHILE YOU'RE IN HIGH SCHOOL

- Begin your school day at the high school, then move to KCC's North Extension Center in Bradley. Classes end in time to participate in high school sports and activities.
- Complete requirements for both high school and college degrees at the same time.
- Build your own program from approved courses. Classes can lead to a bachelor's degree.
- KCC staff helps you plan and map a personalized schedule that can transfer to the college of your choice.
- Support is built in with KCC tutoring, mentors and college transfer guidance.

INVESTMENT

A partnership with KCC, BBCHS and parents helps keep this affordable for families. KCC is giving students a 30% tuition discount for the two year period, to the reduced rate of \$120 per credit hour. You will still need to purchase textbooks and pay applicable course fees. BBCHS is paying for \$1200 per year of the cost. Payment will be made directly to KCC in association of the student's name.

ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

To enroll, you will need to work directly with your high school counselor and complete appropriate paperwork. You will also need to meet course placement requirements. Also, KCC has online tools to help you prepare to take the tests. If your scores need a boost, summer prep courses could help you meet college-level requirements before the start of the fall semester.
